

Designing Computer Networks Subnetting With School Objects Using Cisco Packet Tracer 6.1

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Abstract

The internet is one part that cannot be released in human life today. This increase in internet users causes the availability of ip to decrease. That is because users who will use the internet must have an IP. The availability of IPv4 is currently decreasing. To overcome these problems, IPv6 was made which was announced to replace the existence of IPv4. But another solution that can be taken is using subnetting. With subnetting, IP can be used optimally according to the needs of the host or can make efficient use of IP. And subnetting also functions to avoid congestion resulting from too many hosts on the physical network. And to connect between subnets, routing will be done. The design of computer network subnetting is expected to make efficient use of IP.

1. Introduction

Internet (interconnection-networking) is all communication networks that use electronic intermediaries that can be connected to one another using Transmission Control Protocol / Internet Protocol (TCP / IP). Based on sources from the website of the Ministry of Communication and Information that internet users in the world in 2014 reached 2,892.7 million people, and it is projected that internet users in the world in 2018 will reach 3,600.2 million people. In Indonesia internet users in 2014 reached 83.7 million people and it is projected that in 2018 internet users in Indonesia will reach 123 million people. Based on these data it can be concluded that the more time passes, internet users both in Indonesia and in the world will experience an increase. An increase in internet users will correlate to the increasing number of IPs that must be provided. That is because to be able to connect to the internet the user must get an IP address that will be the identity of that user to be able to use the internet. However, with the IP currently available, it will cause the availability of IP now to be reduced. IP that is still used today is IPv4, so the availability of IPv4 has also been reduced. To anticipate these problems, IPv6 also appeared. IPv6 is declared to replace IPv4. However, other ways that can be used to anticipate these problems can also be done by doing subnetting. Subnetting itself is a division of the network so that IP can be used according to the needs needed. Subnetting can use the IP address as needed so that it can streamline the IP address. Subnetting is done by dividing the IP as needed and routing will be done which functions so that each subnet can communicate with each other.

There are several studies that discuss subnetting, namely research conducted by Lilik Eko Nuryanto with the title Concept of IP Address Subnetting for Internet Efficiency. This study discusses the subnetting conducted at a company that has 4 departments. The concept of subnetting is done to anticipate the occurrence of congestion caused by there are many hosts on a physical network. And there are also other studies written by Mochamad Husni with the title Design of Computer Network Routing Implementation Using Cisco. This research discusses

the making of a design to implement network routing using cisco. Subnetting design is made in a company by using IP class c. The design of this design is intended to streamline the use of IP.

2. Materials and Methods

2.1. IP

IP (Internet Protocol) is a series of binary lifts consisting of 32 bits to 128 bits that function as addresses of users on computers in a computer network. A 32-bit IP is IPv4 and a 128-bit IP is IPv6. IPv4 has 5 classes, namely:

2.2. Subnetting

Subnetting is the division of networks into two or more according to needs. Subnetting has a function to make efficient use and to avoid congestion caused by too many hosts on a physical network. To do subnetting that must be considered is the number of hosts available on IP and the desired host division. To classify IP addresses can be seen in the CIDR (Classless Inter-Domain Routing) table.

2.3. Routing

Routing is a process for directing different networks. Routing can connect between different networks so that different networks can communicate. When viewed from the packet delivery, routing can be divided into 2 namely:

- Direct Routing
Direct routing is addressing the host directly to the destination host without going through another host.
- Indirect Routing
Indirect routing is addressing a host that must go to another host first before being able to go to the destination host.

Routing has 3 types of configurations, namely:

- Minimal Routing
Minimal routing is a simple routing process on the local network.
- Static Routing
Static routing is routing on a network that has many gateways.
- Dynamic Routing
Dynamic routing is routing on networks that have more than one route.

2.4. Packet Tracer

Packet Tracer is a Cisco output application that functions for learning media in the field of networking as well as training and simulation research in the field of networking. The Cisco system was founded by Leonard Bosack and Sandy K. Lerner, they are former staff from Stanford University. The Cisco system was established in 1984. Until now, Cisco Packet Tracer has released the latest version, version 6.2, which can simulate application layer protocols, basic RIP routing, OSPF, and EIGRP.

3. Result and Discussion

3.1. Subnetting

In this subnetting, the IP used is 172.16.160.0 with subnetting distribution based on the needs of the school to be addressed. In this design a simulation will be made for subnetting purposes on:

a. Computer Lab

On the subnet for the computer lab will use IP 172.16.160.0 with netmask used ie / 26 which will provide the number of hosts 62. This netmask is used in order to meet the number of hosts in the computer lab that is 50 hosts. The network used is wired network. The subnetting results obtained are:

3.2. Design Using Packet Tracer

To connect between routers and routers, IP is used starting from IP 172.16.163.0 with netmask used ie /30 which will provide the number of hosts 2. Then to connect between other routers the next IP will be used with the same netmask and so will the next .

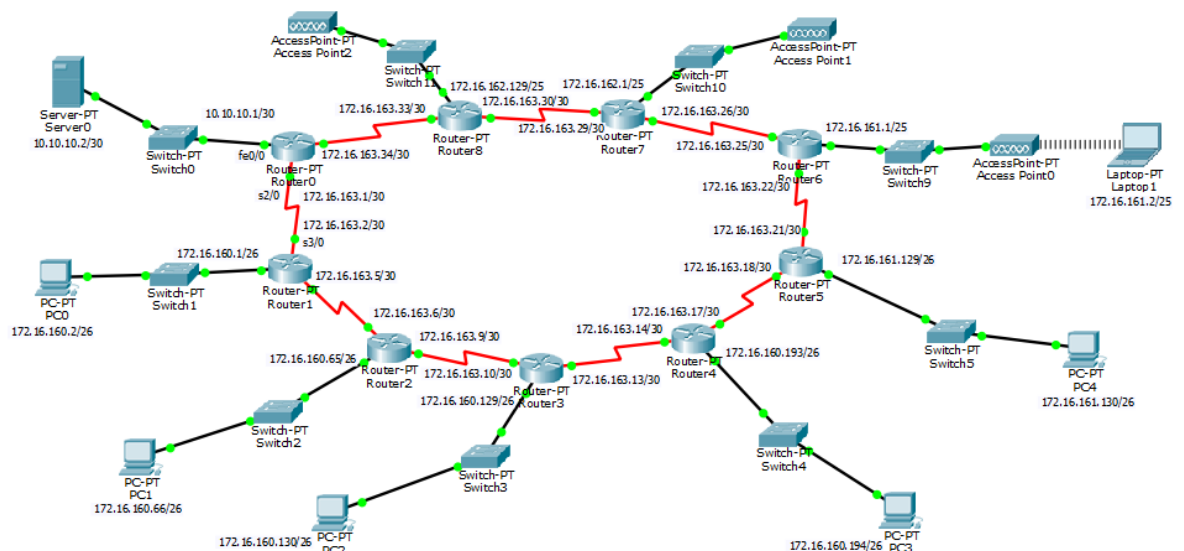


Figure 1. The subnetting design uses packet tracer

Figure 1 is the result of subnetting design that has been done, each subnet in the design has been able to communicate with each other. IP is loaded on the PC and router and for routing the router functions so that each network can communicate. Then also added a gateway for each pc or device that is there. Then routing is done for each router.

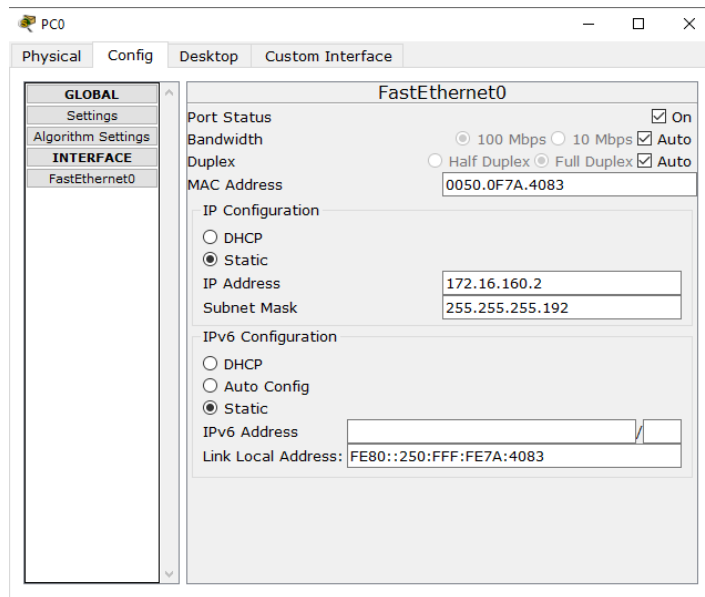


Figure 2. Charging IP on a PC or device

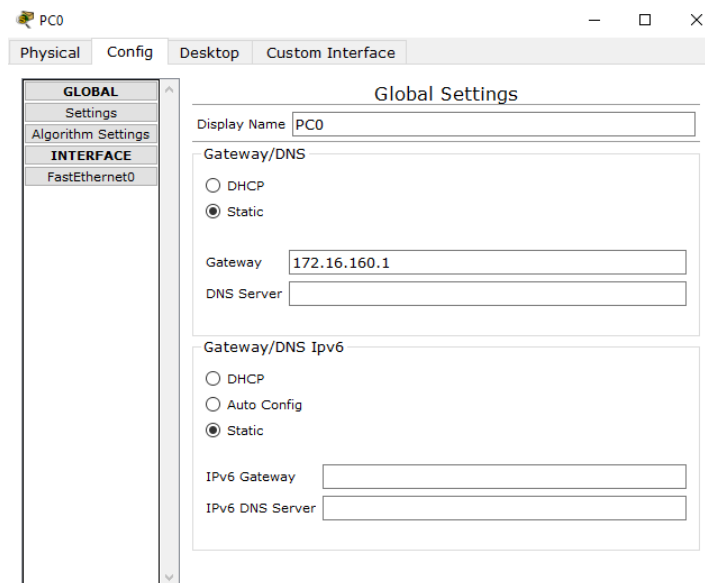


Figure 3. Charging the gateway on a PC or device

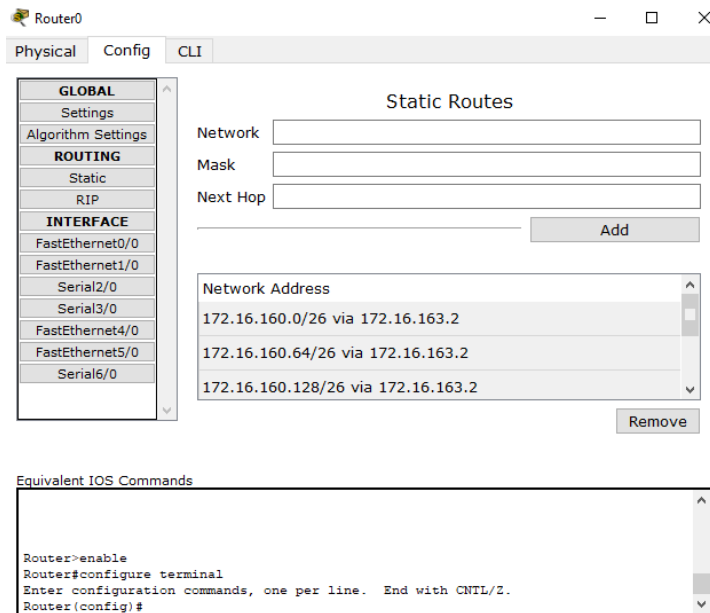


Figure 4. Routing on the router

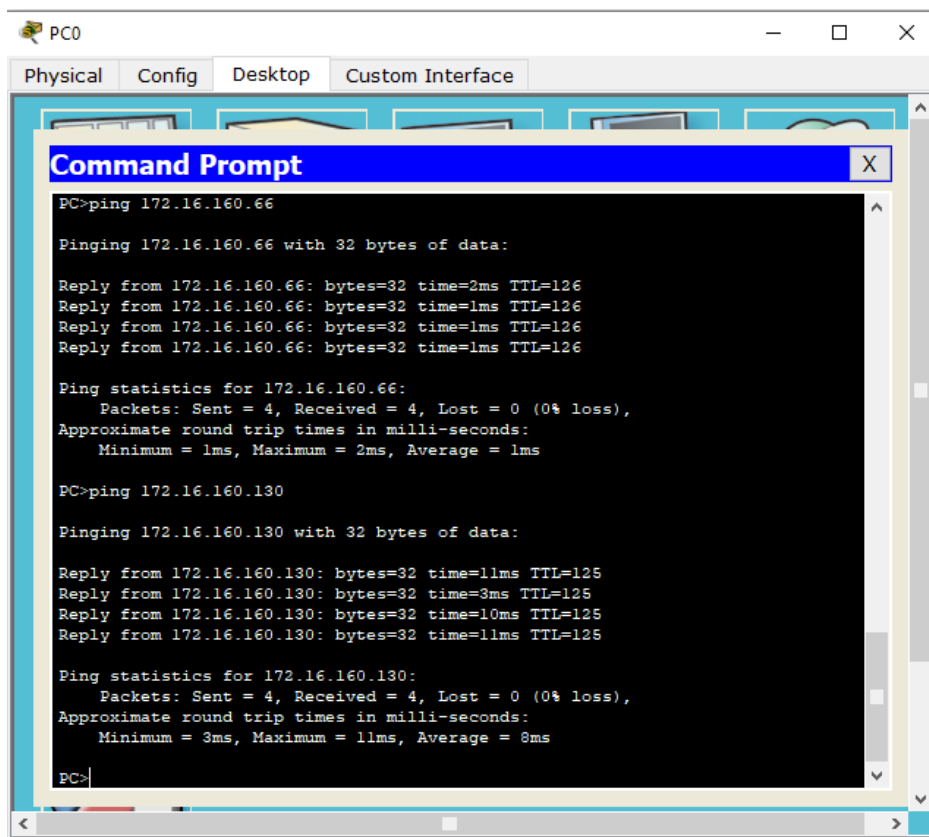


Figure 5. Testing for routing has been done

4. Conclusion
